#### Haydn's "Creation"

Coming to New Brunswick for the first time in forty years – live performances of Franz Joseph Haydn's *The Creation*! The Fredericton Chamber Orchestra and Fredericton Choral Society, conducted by Richard Hornsby, present this great oratorio on April 6, 7:00pm at Wilmot United. Choir director is Heather Dunham. Soloists are soprano Melody Dobson, tenor Michael van der Gaag, bass Paul Bustin.

*The Creation,* written between 1796 and 1798, is considered by many to be Haydn's masterpiece. It depicts and celebrates the creation of the world as described in *Genesis, Psalms* and *Para-dise Lost.* The work will be sung in English. Moncton's Melody Dobson has performed under many internationally renowned conductors in Europe. Michael van der Gaag, from PEI sang with Canada's National Youth Choir, and has performed as tenor soloist in works by Haydn, Mozart, Dvorak, Handel and Rossini. Saint John's Paul Bustin returns to sing with the choir and orchestra as bass soloist, having sung that role in Haydn's *The Seasons* in 2012.
