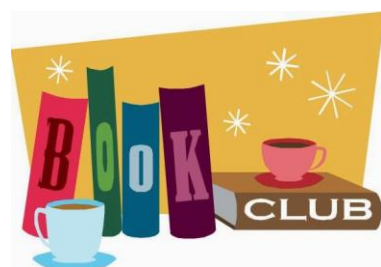


WANT TO BE A MEMBER OF ST. PAUL'S?
